

The Utah 1033 Foundation 2026 Leadership Award Program

Application Rules and Procedures

The Utah 1033 Foundation will award up to three (3) Fallen Hero Leadership Awards, each given in honor of Utah Peace Officers lost in the line of duty since the Utah 1033 Foundation's establishment, and each carrying a stipend of \$5,000, for post-secondary education to qualifying students in 2026, based on a competitive selection process. Winners will be notified in April 2026. Leadership Award funds cannot be claimed without proof of current enrollment at an accredited College, University, or Vocational Certificate Program as designated by The Utah 1033 Foundation, and must be claimed by August 31st, 2028.

Rules for Application to the Leadership Awards Program

- Applicant must be a natural child, legally adopted child, or step-child of a currently actively employed sworn Utah peace officer, *or* be a natural child, legally adopted child, or step-child of a parent/guardian who passed away while actively employed as a sworn Utah peace officer.
- Applicant must have a cumulative High School GPA of at least 3.5, *and* a cumulative College/University/Vocational Certificate Program GPA of at least 3.3 (if applicable)
- Applicant must be a currently enrolled High School Senior, or be currently enrolled in an accredited College, University, or Vocational Certificate Program as a full-time student
- Applicant must be aged 25 or younger
- Applicant must submit a *complete* application packet as described in the "How to Apply" section below via U.S. Mail, *postmarked no later than January 31st*, 2026
- No individual may win more than two Leadership Awards from the Utah 1033 Foundation
- Applicants must not be immediate family members of the Utah 1033 Foundation's staff or Governing Board
- Submitted materials will not be returned
- Applicants will be evaluated on the basis of their respective GPAs, course rigor, and the originality, leadership qualities, and depth of thought reflected in their response to the essay prompt
- Applicants not meeting the criteria as described in this section will not be considered or evaluated
- Incomplete applications will not be considered or evaluated
- Any submitted materials not requested in the "How to Apply" section below will not be considered or evaluated
- Once applicable, each Award recipient agrees to notify The Utah 1033 Foundation of his or her graduation date from College, University, or Vocational Certificate Program, and of the degree or certificate earned

How to Apply

The Utah 1033 Foundation 2026 Leadership Award application packet is available as a download from The Utah 1033 Foundation's website at https://utah1033.org/programs/leadership-awards/ To apply, applicants **must** submit the following:

- Completed Application Form, signed by both 1) the Applicant **and** 2) the Qualifying Parent/Guardian or appropriate Qualifying Parent/Guardian representative (see details on page 2 below)
- Completed Release Form, signed by both 1) the Applicant **and** 2) the Qualifying Parent/Guardian or appropriate Qualifying Parent/Guardian representative (see details on page 3 below)
- A three-page (maximum), double spaced essay in response to the prompt provided on the Application Form
- Official High School and College/University/Vocational Certificate Program transcripts (if applicable). An official high school transcript must be submitted. NOTE: Please ensure that all submitted transcripts are physically marked and sealed OFFICIAL by the issuing institution; self-reported transcripts (i.e. transcripts printed by the student from the institution's web portal, transcripts not submitted in an envelope physically sealed by the issuing institution, etc.) will not be considered or counted towards the completion of the application.
- Self-picture (for use on website, media releases and other marketing materials)
- Submit all required items in a single package to The Utah 1033 Foundation, ATTN: Leadership Awards, P.O. Box 4522, Park City, UT 84060. Applications must be postmarked by January 31, 2026.

Please include a separate essay (no more than three pages, double spaced) in response to the following prompt. Please feel free to conduct research and to ask friends, parents, teachers, mentors, colleagues, etc. for their opinions and knowledge – the more research you do and the more you discuss this topic with others before sitting down to write, the more "tested" your ideas may be, but please write the essay in your own voice and make sure it represents your own work, with references cited for any non-original thoughts and arguments per MLA works cited guidelines.

• Based on your research, have political and civic discourse in the United States become more polarized in recent years? If you believe so, what does your research suggest as root causes? If you believe not, how does your research back your assertion? In either case, do you believe the current situation is ideal and should be preserved, or do you think change is needed? As a future leader, based on your research regarding the current situation, what would you do either to 1) preserve the status quo or 2) foster appropriate change? What might the future consequences be if your proposed actions aren't taken, and why will your proposed actions prove beneficial and effective? Defend your position.
